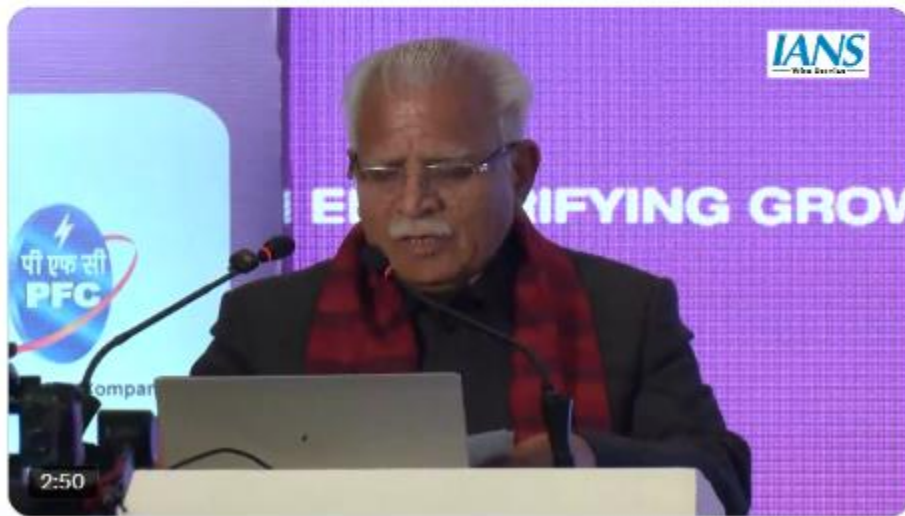

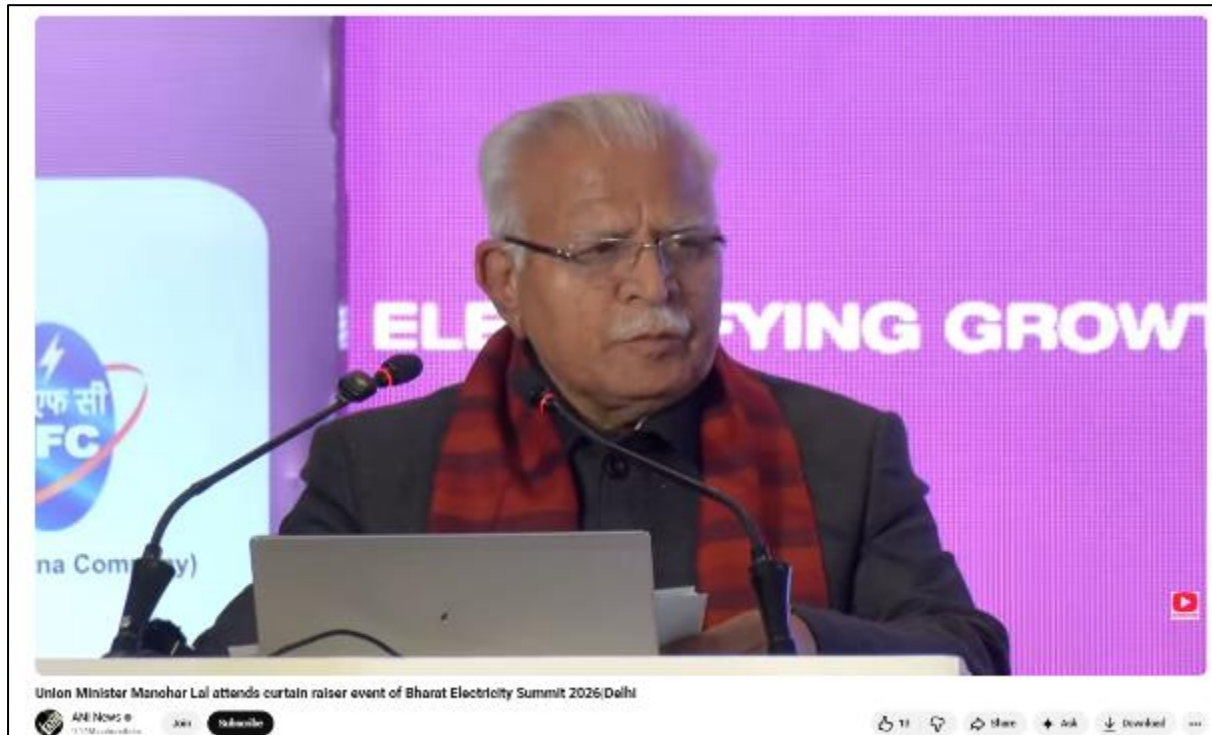

India's installed power generation capacity more than doubled over the past decade

New Delhi: Power minister Manohar Lal on Thursday said the investment potential in India's power sector is around \$450 billion by 2032, driven by large-scale expansion in electricity generation, transmission, distribution and energy storage.

Speaking at the curtain raiser event for the Bharat Electricity Summit, Lal said the country has moved decisively from a power-deficit phase to a surplus regime, allowing policymakers to plan for long-term growth, reliability and clean energy integration.

Bharat Electricity Summit 2026 will be held from March 19 to 22 in New Delhi.

"India is no longer addressing shortages. We are managing surplus power, strengthening grid resilience and preparing for rapidly rising demand. This

transition will require sustained investments across generation, transmission, distribution and energy storage," the minister said.

Over \$345.97 billion in electricity generation is expected in the next seven years. The transmission and distribution sector has an additional potential of \$68.22 billion.

The energy storage sector alone offers an opportunity of \$35.21 billion, he said.

The addition in transmission reflects the measures to evacuate renewable power from resource-rich regions and strengthen grid reliability.

The energy storage segment include battery energy storage systems and pumped storage projects.

Lal highlighted that India's installed power generation capacity has more than doubled over the past decade from to over 510 GW in November 2025 from 249 GW in March 2014.

He said the country successfully met a record all-India peak demand of 250 GW in 2024, underscoring the growing robustness of the national grid.

India has already achieved 52% non-fossil fuel capacity in its installed power mix, the minister said.

INDIA'S POWER SECTOR is poised to enter a fresh investment cycle, with cumulative investments of around ₹4.5 lakh crore projected by 2032. The surge will be driven by large-scale expansion across electricity generation, transmission, distribution and energy storage, Union Power Minister Manohar Lal Khattar said on Thursday.

Speaking at the curtain raiser for the Bharat Electricity Summit (BES) 2026, Khattar said India has decisively moved from a power-deficit phase to a surplus regime, enabling policy-makers to focus on long-term growth, system reliability and the integration of clean energy.

The summit will be held from March 19 to 22 at Yashobhoomi, New Delhi.

"India is no longer addressing shortages. We are managing surplus power, strengthening grid resilience and preparing for rapidly rising demand. This transition will require sustained investments across generation, transmission, distribution and energy storage," the minister said.

According to estimates shared at the event, the largest share of the investment opportunity lies in power generation, which is expected to attract about \$346 billion by 2032.



India's electricity consumption has been growing steadily over the past decade, driven by industrial expansion, urbanisation, rising household incomes and the rapid electrification of transport, cooking and agriculture. According to official estimates, peak power demand has already crossed 250 gigawatts and is expected to double by 2040, placing unprecedented pressure on existing infrastructure.

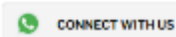

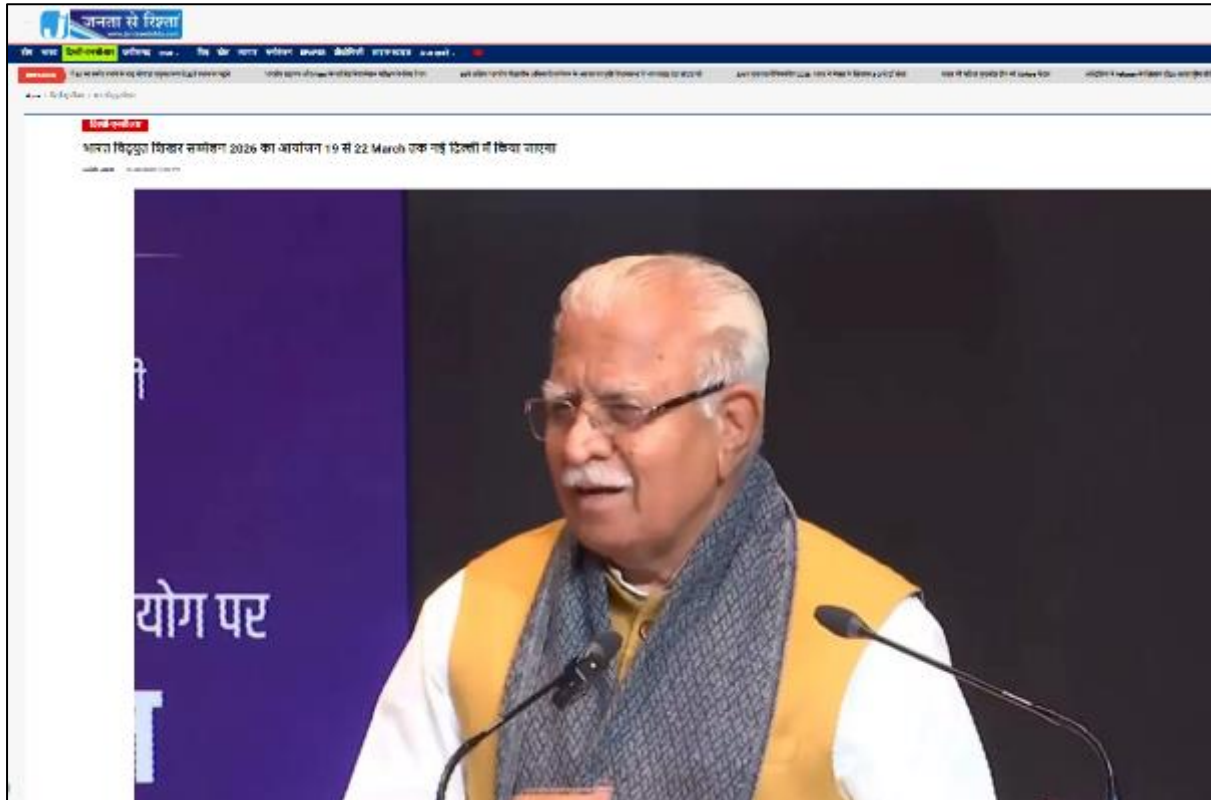

Overview

India is adding 4-5 GW of power capacity monthly to its current 514 GW base as demand is expected to double by 2040. The government announced a \$3.03 trillion smart meter initiative to reduce discom losses and improve profitability. Since 2014, India has added over 178 GW of renewable capacity, including 130 GW solar and 32.9 GW wind. The Power Ministry has identified investment opportunities worth \$345 billion in generation, \$68.22 billion in transmission, and \$35 billion in energy storage.
